



NADA Conference Scholarship Program

NADA invites expressions of interest for the Conference Scholarship Program to attend, and actively participate in, the NADA Conference 2018: Exploring therapeutic interventions in Sydney on 7-8 June 2018.

Applications are sought from individuals who are keen to engage with the AOD sector. This is an opportunity to engage with treatment practitioners to review, share and examine best practice evidence based interventions with researchers, policy makers and service planners across NSW.

Scholarships

Two types of scholarships are available for individuals with a demonstrated interest in promoting evidence based interventions and addressing the diverse and complex needs of people accessing AOD services.

- **Consumer scholarship (5 available)**
To be eligible for this scholarship, an individual must be a consumer or be a member of a consumer advisory group.
- **Staff/Volunteer scholarship (5 available)**
To be eligible for this scholarship, an individual must be a staff member or volunteer of a NSW organisation with less than 12 workers.

Successful applicants will receive:

- **Free two-day registration**
- Access to all conference sessions (excluding the Awards Dinner)
- Conference pack
- Opportunity to participate in conversations and network with conference speakers and delegates

Accommodation and flights are not included in the scholarship. Individuals will be responsible for arranging their own travel. NADA members may be eligible to receive a travel subsidy to attend the conference. For more information, please view the NADA [travel subsidy guidelines](#).

Who can apply

Applications are invited from all individuals who meet the eligibility criteria for each scholarship, are available to attend both days of the conference and who are keen to engage with the AOD sector.

Applications are encouraged from:

- Individuals that have never attended a NADA conference
- Under 25 years old
- Identify as culturally or linguistically diverse
- Identify as Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander
- Identify as LGBTI

Screening and selection process

A selection panel will be formed comprising representatives from the Conference Organising committee. The selection panel will review the applications, make recommendations and develop a shortlist of applicants based on the quality of the applications and the number of spots available for the program. The decisions of the panel are final.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application in May 2018.
