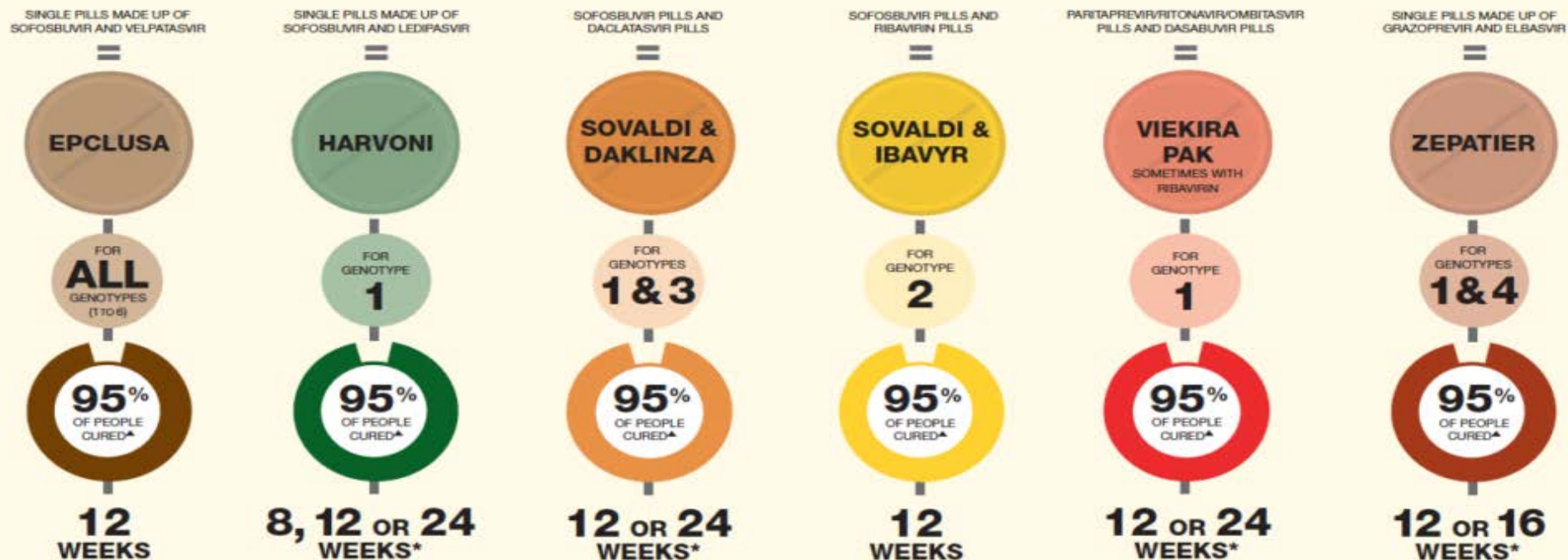

HCV CLINIC OUTCOMES FOR 2017

DATE OF INTERVENTION	CLIENT NUMBER	TREATMENT AND/OR OUTCOMES
7/03/2017	1	<p>Intervention commenced at an outpatient drug and alcohol facility, she transferred to Jarrah House and continued to be supported by a mental health outreach worker who provided the medication. Self discharged prior to completing treatment, unfortunately she stopped taking her medication once she returned to the community.</p>
7/03/2017	2	<p>Treatment commenced, completed the Jarrah House program, returned to the community, attended the outpatient program and was seen in the HCV clinic at Jarrah House on those days. Treatment completed, still awaiting final blood test results 12 week post end of treatment.</p> <p>Client commenced medication 19 days after admission into the facility.</p>

HCV CLINIC OUTCOMES FOR 2017

DATE OF INTERVENTION	CLIENT NUMBER	TREATMENT AND/OR OUTCOMES
7/03/2017	3	Admitted to the Jarrah House, unable to commence treatment due to pregnancy, linked in to a specialist service for follow up post delivery.
6/04/2017	4	Commenced treatment 25/04/17 only requiring 8 weeks of treatment. Completed the Jarrah House program and transferred to another residential facility. Discharged with a letter to give to a community GP. Final blood test carried out and revealed she had a sustained virological response meaning a “cure”
